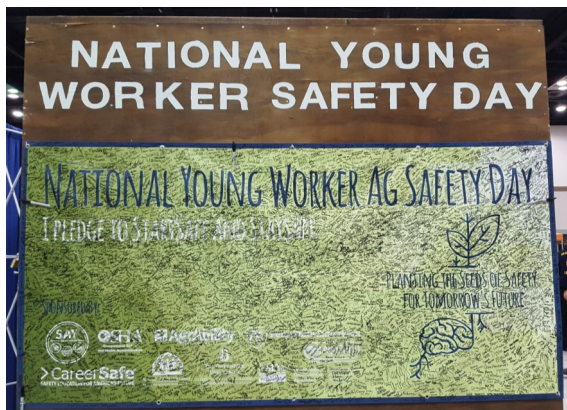

The new area was a huge success and made possible with the enthusiastic involvement of AgriSafe, CareerSafe, National AgrAbility Project, National Children's Center, Ohio State Ag Safety & Health Program, and SAY Project (Penn State Ag Safety & Health Program).
