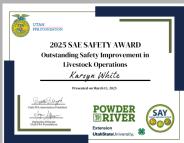

In February, the SAY Project was presented Livestock Safety and SAE practices to the Utah Association for Agricultural Educators . This was the kickoff of their Supervised Agricultural Experience Safety Awards sponsored by Powder River Livestock Equipment.

Awards were given for Outstanding Safety Improvement for Livestock Production and Outstanding Safety Improvement for Agribusiness. The program award levels were honorable mention, second runner-up, and first runner-up in both categories. \$1,700 total SAE Safety Award breakdown as a cash prize for students' SAE project and safety award applications. For both categories, the award breakdown was the following:
