In February, the SAY Project was presented Livestock Safety and SAE practices to the Utah Association for Agricultural Educators . This was the kickoff of their Supervised Agricultural Experience Safety Awards sponsored by Powder River Livestock Equipment. Awards were given for Outstanding Safety Improvement for Livestock Production and Outstanding Safety Improvement for Agribusiness. The program award levels were honorable mention, second runner-up, and first runner-up in both categories. \$1,700 total SAE Safety Award breakdown as a cash prize for students' SAE project and safety award applications. For both categories, the award breakdown was the following:

- \$500 Outstanding Safety Improvement
- \$200 1st Runner-up
- \$100 2nd Runner-up
- \$50 Honorable mention

Formal Curriculum refers to material that: 1) has learning goals or objectives that are clearly stated; 2) includes subject matter content supportive of the learning goals or objectives; and 3) has an evaluation component (e.g., some type of student assessment, such as a quiz).

Other Supporting Resource refers to individualized, originally authored resources, such as technical fact sheet series, video clips, PowerPoint presentations, or other materials that lack one or more of the 3 elements of a Formal Curriculum.
